
BOOKLETS


There are two booklets to print, cut-out and fold; 'How to Play' and the 'Special Cards Guide'.

- Print page 1 of 'How to Play' onto paper then flip it over and Print page 2 on the other side.
- 2. Cut as indicated, then score and fold as shown below.











3. Repeat to make the 'Special Cards Guide'.



CARDS

- 1. Print pages 1 20 onto a suitable thickness of card.
- 2. Print the last page (21) onto the reverse of each sheet of card, alien mind control will sometimes cause orientation problems so take care...
- 3. Cut out the cards. There are 180 so watch those fingers.








BOX

- 1. Print the two 'box' pages (TOP and BOTTOM) onto suitable card, the same as used for printing the cards worked fine for me.
- 2. Cut out and assemble the box TOP.







The box will provide a cosy home for your 'Are You An Alien?' cards.

However, depending on the thickness of card used the <u>height</u> of your stack of 180 cards will probably be different to any other.

that's it!

TOP done

To address this the box BOTTOM can be custom cut to accommodate a range of deck heights.


To make the box BOTTOM - first, measure the height of your deck plus the two booklets. We'll call this distance 'X'.

BOX (continued)

4. On the printed sheet measure your distance 'X' from the box base to the three edges indicated.


Note; I've had to impose a minimum and maximum 'X' distance but the range should be sufficient.

5. Make the three cuts shown.





Note; For this example I cut midway between MAX and MIN.

6. That's the tricky bit done, now cut out the rest of the net, score the folds and glue...










BOX (continued)

7. All that remains is to join the box TOP to the box BOTTOM;



slide the box TOP down onto the box BOTTOM as far as it will go, be gentle...



then glue the back flap of the box TOP to the back of the box BOTTOM

ensure the two back halves are tightly butted together as you do so.





7. All done. Put the cards in (and the booklets) and close it up.
